ACCOMPLISHMENTS


- BOX CREEK WILDERNESS AGGREGATION Successfully brokered the purchase of one of the largest assemblages of old growth forest in North Carolina.
- BOX CREEK WILDERNESS POWER LINE Successfully strategized and implemented the prevention of a high voltage power line across Box Creek Wilderness.
- CHESTNUT PLANTINGS Successfully planted the largest number of native chestnuts in North America in a single restoration area.
- CONSERVATION REAL ESTATE Successfully aggregated over 42,000 acres of land, primarily for conservation purposes. Outcomes included:
 - Box Creek Wilderness Natural Heritage Area.
 - One of the largest USFWS conservation easements in North Carolina.
 - The largest preservation mitigation bank in North Carolina.
 - Colington Island Meter Point Registered Heritage Area (soon to be under NC State Ownership).
 - Addition to South Mountains State Park.
 - Expansion of Mountain Bog National Wildlife Reserve.


